

## Example: Five Reasons Deep

**Problem statement:** “At risk” students are often disruptive in class.

**Q1. Why are they disruptive?**

- They are frustrated.

**Q2. What is causing the frustration?**

- The work is too hard.

**Q3. Why are we assigning work that is too hard?**

- They are all expected to do the same assignments.

**Q4. If it interferes with learning, why would we assign the same work to all?**

- Too few teachers think it is their job to modify the work.
